Reminder for Sick Students

Parents are reminded that if a child has a cough, fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, they are to stay home from school until they are symptom free for 48 hours, if it is not Covid-19 related. If it is Covid-19 related, they may return to school after 5 days if they are symptom free without medication, or you have a recent negative test result, or a note from their pediatrician. They must wear a mask for 5 days after return, even if you have signed an opt-out form. Sending a child to school before they are symptom free often sends the child into a relapse causing them to miss more school and it also can spread to other children. Thank you for helping us to keep all of our children and staff healthy, happy and in school!
